

Announcement from Rajamangala University of Technology Srivijaya on Life on Land A.D. 2023

RUTS has a policy and goals for sustainable development, aiming to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) set three by the United Nations. This is pursued through policies and action plans aimed at developing the organization and related units, in response to the needs of the current generation. The university has therefore established the following policies.

1. Supporting land ecosystems through education.

1.1 Support or organize events aimed to promote conservation and sustainable utilization of the land, including forests and wild land.

1.2 Ensure that food on campus is sustainable farmed.

1.3 Maintain and extend existing ecosystems and their biodiversity, of both plants and animals, especially ecosystems under threat.

1.4 Offer educational programmes on ecosystems for local or national communities.

1.5 Offer educational programme/outreach for local or national communities on sustainable management of land for agriculture.

1.6 Offer educational programme/outreach for local or national communities on sustainable management of land tourism.

2. Supporting land ecosystems through action.

2.1 Ensure the conservation, restoration and sustainable use of terrestrial ecosystems associated with the university, in particular forests, mountains and drylands.

2.2 Identify, monitor and protect any IUCN Red Listed species and national conservation list species with habits in areas affected by the operation.

2.3 Plan local biodiversity and develop process e.g. construction of new buildings.

2.4 Reduce the impact of alien species on campus.

2.4 Collaborate with the local community to maintain shared land ecosystems.

3. Land sensitive waste disposal.

3.1 Uphold water quality in order to protect ecosystems, wildlife, and human health and welfare.

3.2 Reduce plastic waste on campus.

3.3 Practice on waste disposal covering hazardous materials.
